Purpose of the Role and Person Specification

Assisting and deputising for the Centre Lead you will help to ensure the Imaging Centre operates smoothly and efficiently.

The participant experience will be of paramount importance to you and you will ensure that participants are assessed in a timely manner whilst overseeing the acquisition of MRI brain, cardiac and abdomen scans, DXA scans and carotid ultrasound scans to UK Biobank's quality standards. This will involve an element of data analysis and QA (both routine and ad hoc).

You will work with the Centre Lead Radiographer to ensure all staff adhere to our incidental findings procedure, reviewing and escalating any suspected findings of a potentially serious nature, and dealing with any staff queries in the absence of the Centre Lead.

You will have direct line management responsibility for a sub-team, conducting appraisals and assisting the Centre Lead Radiographer with staff training when necessary. Therefore some experience of people management would be desirable.
